## Proposed Plan Change 120 - Housing Intensification and Resilience, using streamlined planning process

## Sections 80B and 80C and Part 5 of Schedule 1, Resource Management Act 1991

Auckland Council has prepared the following proposed change to the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part) in accordance with the streamlined planning process:

Proposed Plan Change 120 - Housing Intensification and Resilience, responds to a government requirement to enable more opportunities for housing and development, mainly through the rezoning of land to allow for significant increases in building heights in many parts of the city. The focus of the changes is on locations close to the city centre and other commercial centres, train and busway stations, and along a number of main bus routes. Proposed Plan Change 120 would also strengthen the rules in the Auckland Unitary Plan that relate to building in areas prone to natural hazards (for example within flood plains and in some coastal locations). This includes applying a 'restrictive residential zone' to residential areas with the highest risk of natural hazards.

  - adversely affects the environment; and
  - does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.
- a local authority in its own area.
